Do we accept both self-funded and state-funded residents	We accept residents who are both funding their own care, and also will accept Local Authority rates with a third party top up payment.

The care needs we cater for	<ul> <li>Early onset dementia through to advanced dementia (subject to assessment)</li> <li>Respite stays</li> </ul>
Overview of our rooms and facilities	All rooms have en-suite shower wet rooms. The downstairs rooms have patio doors into our large garden. Upstairs there is a large balcony. There is a communal lounge, cinema, hair saloon and dining area.
Size of the home	Suitable to accommodate 60 residents
Brief description of staffing arrangements	A 1:4 ratio of staff to residents upstairs and 1:6 downstairs. We have at least two Care Team Leaders on day shift and two at night. Three Heads of Care are on call 24/7. We have two chefs, a kitchen team, an activities team, maintenance team and a house keeper team. We also have a Customer Relations Manager plus a GP round weekly and Occupational Therapy service

Surprising or important terms and conditions	<ul> <li>Respite stay residents are required to pay for their stay upfront.</li> <li>For permanent residents, payment is by direct debit with two months taken for the first payment and monthly thereafter.</li> </ul>

How self-funded residents fees may change during their stay	Fees are reviewed annually each April, or if there is a increase in complexity of need.
